## DAILY MINYAN

The Daily Minyan is one of the oldest traditions in Jewish ritual. It allows a person to pray in the atmosphere of camaraderie and to share a feeling of rootedness in a community. Jewish law prescribes that certain prayers may only be said in the company of a minyan, one of which is the Kaddish, said during the time of mourning or on the occurrence of a Yahrzeit.

Our synagogue has a fine congregation, and it is important for us to maintain a thriving Daily Minyan. We can and we will, with your help. All you have to do is set aside a time slot convenient for you (one day each week) and get up a little earlier those mornings or clear up some time in the evening. You will enjoy the interaction of being among friends; you will be doing a mitzvah; and you will be keeping our Daily Minyan strong and vibrant. Don't forget the Minyanim on Sunday mornings and evenings.

The current schedule for the Daily Minyan is as follows:

Monday - Friday..... 6:45 A.M.  
Sunday ..... 8:00 A.M.

Evening Services Sun.-Thurs. 7 p.m.

Friday and Saturday Evening Services correspond with the candle lighting time of the Friday night of that weekend.

Morning Services on Monday, May 29<sup>th</sup> will be at 8:00 A.M. for Memorial Day.

## THE ALBERT P. MITNICK AND MILTON M. WEISS CENTURY CLUB

The Century Club was started many years ago by Albert Mitnick to help satisfy our Synagogue's financial needs. After his passing, the late Milton Weiss took up the responsibility. Our Synagogue has never denied membership to anyone unable to meet our dues structure. Today of our families, 31.8% are two member families, 35.5% are single member families, 13.6% are one and two member associate families, and 19.1% of our families are unable to pay the required dues structure. These factors and other considerations result in income from dues to be far less than 25% of our yearly budget requirements. Only the yearly appeal and Ad Book returns exceed the income from Century Club participants.
